The BridgeTech program is a competitive program that will select up to 100 of the top applicants. For those offered a place in this program, there is no course fee. Please note that this is a nationally run program and participants are expected to attend face-to-face events that are held at different locations around Australia - and in particular will gain valuable connections and expertise at the intensive 3 day symposium.

PITCHTECH COMPETITION

As part of the BridgeTech program, participants have the opportunity to participate in the PitchTech Competition. The top 2 pitches will be awarded an industry based internship and attendance at a key sector conference.

ELIGIBILITY

This exclusive program is open to mid-career scientists, researchers, academics, related industry professionals and entrepreneurs across Australia within the medical technology sector.

PROGRAM OUTLINE

The BridgeTech Program provides the practical skills in relation to the commercialisation of medical technology including devices & diagnostics. The focus of the training program will be on the scientific, legal, financial, clinical, regulatory and reimbursement disciplines that contribute to research translation, nationally and internationally.

TOPICS TO BE COVERED FACE-TO-FACE:

- Protecting intellectual property
- Structuring biotech financing deals
- Designing clinical trials to shorten regulatory approval processes
- Enhancing reimbursement returns
