Up to 100 participants are selected annually from across Australia. The program is targeted to mid-career professionals but can also include early and later professionals seeking to expand their commercialisation knowledge and networks including:

- clinicians and healthcare workers
- venture capitalists
- legal practitioners including IP lawyers and patent attorneys
- business development managers and tech transfer professionals
