## Will Automated Vehicles collect data?



Similar to planes, a "black box" will collect crash-related data in the seconds before and during a crash. It is likely who was in control of the vehicle will also be recorded.



What will record the data?













The event data recorder and sensor data have limited value on their own in identifying individuals. However, when combined with data from other networks and in-vehicle technologies, and vehicle-to-vehicle (V2V)/vehicle-to-infrastructure (V2I) communication, significant personal information may be revealed.
