- Criteria-Referenced-Assessment (CRA) sheets make expectations for an assignment explicit for both lecturers and students. In addition to their role in the assessment *of learning* (summative), they can be used as assessment *for learning* (formative). They have the potential to help students develop understanding and skill, as well as make dependable judgments about the quality of their own work.
