- Use language at the level of the learner.
- Paced at the speed of the learner.
- Malleable, able to be reshaped, formed differently.
- Reconstituted or repeated as often as necessary without hints of frustration about the learner.
- Illustrated with examples meaningful to the learner.
- Not single-sourced.
- Always made better.
