Public transport

QUT Gardens Point is very well serviced by public transport. We suggest using the [Translink Journey Planner](#) to plan your visit.

On foot

There is pedestrian access from the city centre via George Street, or from Southbank Parklands via the Goodwill Bridge. Both are a short walk to QUT Gardens Point campus.

Wheelchair accessibility

QUT has an ongoing commitment to ensure that all buildings are accessible for visitors who use a wheelchair or motorised scooter. A taxi drop off and short-term parking zone (5 minutes) is located outside Parliament House in George Street, a short distance from Gardens Theatre. There are a number of designated [Disability Parking bays](#) exclusively reserved for visitors who hold a Disability Parking permit.

Parking

Pay-on-exit public car parks are available within a short walking distance of Gardens Theatre. A car park is located underground in the Science and Engineering Centre (P-block) and under the Riverside Expressway. Several Pay Stations, which accept both cash and card, are located in and near the car parks.

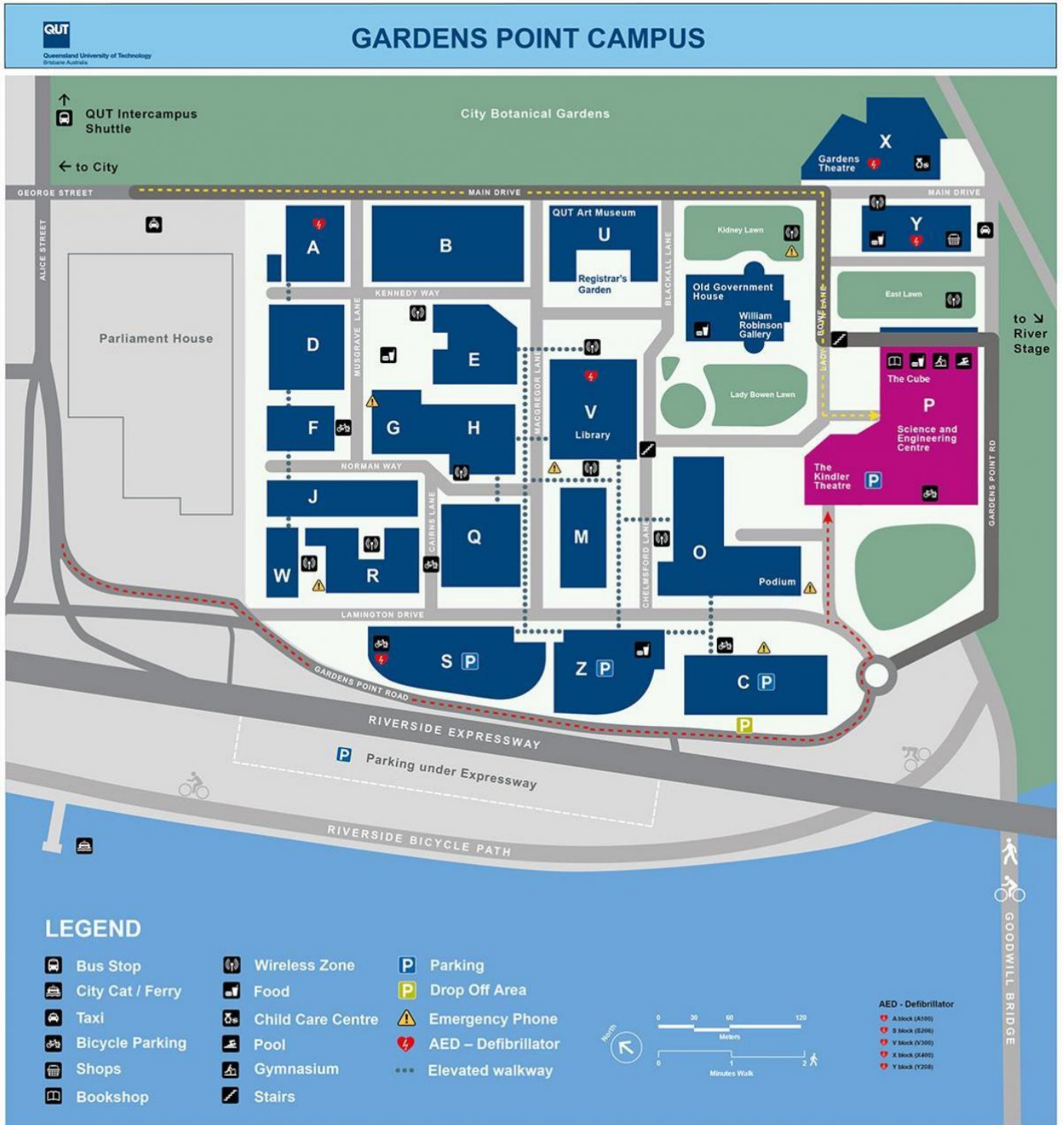

Event Transport

Free transport has been arranged to get from Brisbane City to CSIRO Pullenvale. The buses will depart from **Stop 95 – Alice Street, Brisbane City** at 8:15am sharp on Tuesday 6th February. They return to Brisbane City, departing from CSIRO Pullenvale at 2:30pm sharp.

Public transport

CityXpress bus service number 444 operates from the city; Cultural Centre or King George Square busways; direct to QCAT (the QCAT stop name is "QCAT"). The 444 also goes through the Indooroopilly bus station (located at Indooroopilly Shopping Town) which connects with many other services including the Great Circle Line.

Note that the bus stop is about 300m before the QCAT entrance. So, if coming from the city, continue to walk in the direction that the bus was going. Cross the road and take the first right turn into the Woodcrest housing estate. Turn right at the roundabout and you will see the QCAT entrance. Follow signs to reception.
